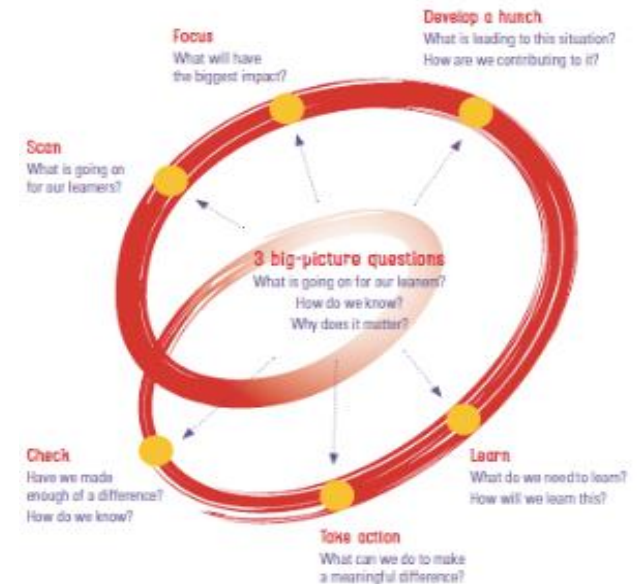

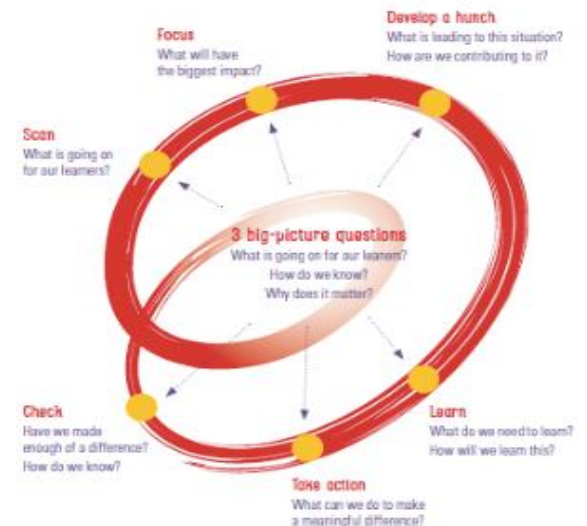

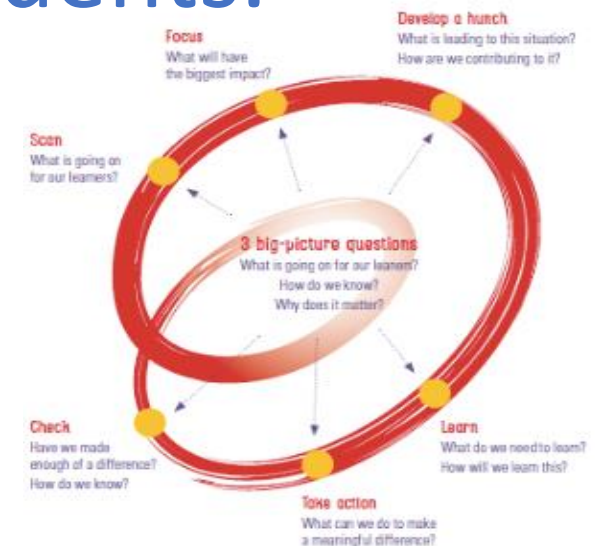
TELP – Framework of Inquiry

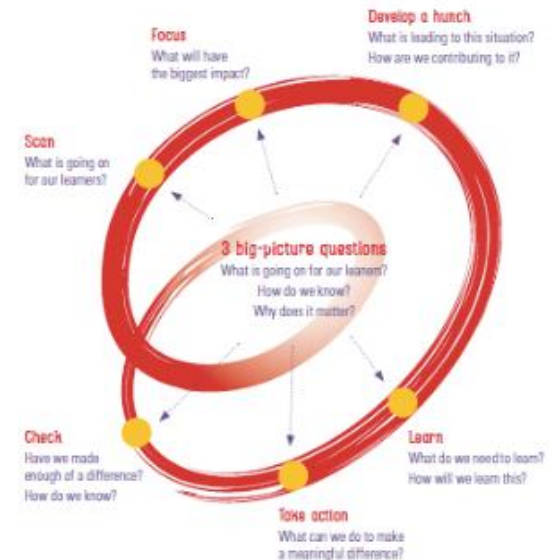
TELP – Learning Organizations
